
**Restrictions, conditions or stipulations in terms of regulation 3(1)(b)**

- The owner/manager undertakes to carry out remedial measures should any public health nuisance arise from activities conducted on the premises.
- Permission is granted for storage and distribution of pre-packed non-perishable food products ie. (spices, herbs, pulses, beans, maize, rice, peas, nuts, wheat, barley, malt, teff, ginger, popcorn, etc). Strictly, no processing, re-packaging, of any food products to be undertaken on the premises without prior permission of this Department.
- Entire premises to be maintained in a clean and tidy condition at all times.
- Suitable protective clothing / equipment relevant to employees work task/duty is to be provided and cleaned on a daily basis.
- All Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants must be labeled in accordance to Regulations R146 -relating to the labeling and advertising of foodstuffs.
- Suitable segregation of food and non-food products must be place whilst in storage.
- Ensure compliance with Tobacco Products Amendment Act no 63 of 2008 by declaring the premises either "Non Smoking" or designating a smoking area in accordance with the Act.


**D NOTES:**
